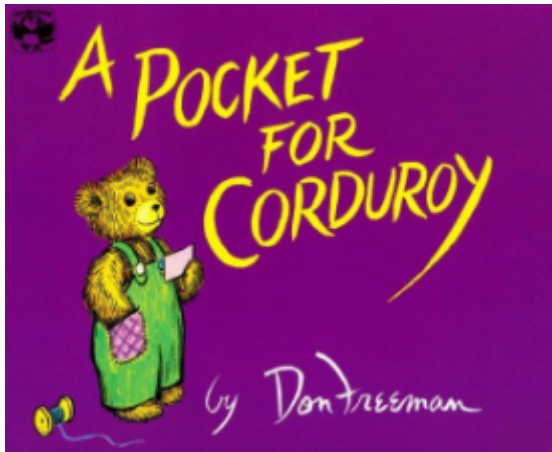

- Ask, "What was Corduroy looking for when he got down from the chair at the laundromat?"
- Ask, "What did Corduroy think the laundry bag of wet clothes was?"
- Ask, "What did Corduroy think the soap powder was?"
- Ask, "Do you have pockets in any of your clothes? What are some things you put in your pockets?"
- Point to the picture on the last page. Ask, "How do you think Corduroy is feeling?"
